Before your vaccination

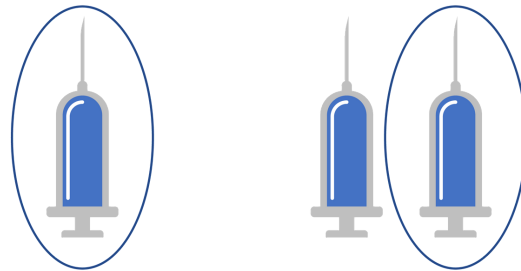
1. Do you feel ill today?

2. Do you have any severe allergies?

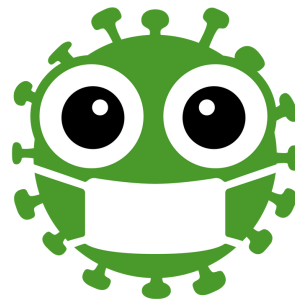
- If **yes**, do you have an allergy to polyethylene glycol (PEG), which is found in some medications, such as laxatives and preparations for colonoscopy procedures?

About the vaccination

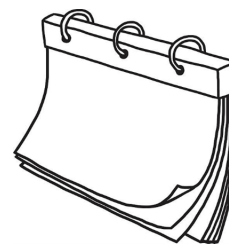
Common vaccine side effects: pain, swelling and redness at injection site, fever, fatigue, chills, headache.

Uncommon vaccine side effects: Enlarged lymph nodes

Signs of allergic reaction: rash, hives, swelling in throat, trouble breathing. If this occurs, seek medical care immediately.

If you experience the following common side effects after vaccination, please do the following;
